## Elizabeth Chiles • Stardust Dialogues • El Zaguán, Santa Fe August 1–30

Richard Levy Gallery is pleased to present <u>Stardust Dialogues</u>, a selection of photographs by Austin-based artist and educator <u>Elizabeth Chiles</u>. The exhibition is being presented in partnership with the Historic Santa Fe Foundation at the gallery at El Zaguán in Santa Fe. The exhibition and programming explore concepts of time, perception, and eco-spirituality. *Stardust Dialogues* is presented over the month of August.

Elizabeth Chiles works with flowers and digital collage techniques to explore the relationship between the tangible and the immaterial. Layers of transparent linen fabric, cutout plant forms, and silhouettes are digitally woven together. Throughout *Stardust Dialogues*, Chiles draws attention to vital and intangible forces—light, time, and energy—found in every aspect of nature. The artist lives and works in Austin, TX.

Richard Levy Gallery fosters a mission to support contemporary artists by providing exposure for artists in the international marketplace both in the gallery and online. The gallery presents gallery exhibitions at their brick and mortar space in downtown Albuquerque, produces periodic satellite pop up projects, and participates in select art fairs. Richard Levy Gallery was established in 1991.

The Gallery at El Zaguán is operated by the Historic Santa Fe Foundation, a 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization. The gallery hosts monthly exhibitions and talks featuring regional artists. All sales support both the artists and the Historic Santa Fe Foundation. HSFF's mission is to preserve, protect, and promote the historic properties and diverse cultural heritage of the Santa Fe area and to educate the public about Santa Fe's history and the importance of preservation
